

Children's Tuition Grant (CTG) Program Calculation Examples

Examples are based on the deductible and tuition grant amount for the 2009/2010 academic year.

University A Example (No Scholarships and no NC Legislative Grant)

Facts About University A

Tuition for University A	\$18,742.50 per semester
Scholarships	None

Tuition Grant Program Info

CTG Deductible	\$1,980 per semester
Maximum Duke Tuition Grant payment	\$14,056.88 per semester

Calculation:

Tuition for University A:	\$18,742	per semester
MINUS CTG Deductible:	- \$1,980	per semester
TOTAL	\$16,762	per semester

\$16,762 is greater than the maximum allowable tuition grant payment of \$14,056.88 per semester

****Amount of tuition grant payment = \$14,056.88 per semester****

University B Example (No Scholarships, eligible for NC Legislative Grant)

Facts About University B

Tuition for University B	\$9,349 per semester
Scholarships	None
NC Legislative Grant*	\$975 per semester

CTG Deductible	\$1,980 per semester
Maximum Duke Tuition Grant payment	\$14,056.88 per semester

*NC Legislative Grant is included in the CTG Deductible. The NC Legislative Grant is available to eligible NC residents attending certain private schools in North Carolina. Contact your child's school for more information.

Calculation:

Tuition for University B:	\$9,349	per semester
MINUS CTG Deductible:	- \$1,980	per semester
TOTAL	\$7,369	per semester

****Amount of tuition grant payment = \$7,369 per semester****

University C Example (Student is Receiving Scholarship)

Facts About University C

Tuition for University C	\$12,556 per semester
Scholarship	\$4,000 per semester
Room and Board	\$6,000 per semester
Fees	\$300 per semester

CTG Deductible	\$1,980 per semester
Maximum Duke Tuition Grant payment	\$14,056.88 per semester

Calculation under Scenario One:

If the scholarship is **not designated** towards tuition and **not greater than room, board, and fees**, then the scholarship has no impact on Children's Tuition Grant payment.

Room, board, and fees are \$6,300 per semester. There is no impact on the CTG payment because the undesignated scholarship of \$4,000 is not greater than the \$6,300 for room, board, and fees.

Tuition for University C:	\$12,556	per semester
MINUS CTG Deductible:	- \$1,980	per semester
TOTAL	\$10,576	per semester

****Amount of tuition grant payment = \$10,576 per semester****

Please Note: If the scholarship is **not designated** towards tuition and **is greater than room, board, and fees**, then the amount over room, board, and fees will be deducted from the tuition grant payment and the deductible still applies.

Calculation under Scenario Two:

If the scholarship is **designated towards tuition**, then the scholarship will be applied towards meeting the deductible and any amount over the deductible will reduce the amount of the tuition grant payment.

Tuition for University C:	\$12,556	per semester
MINUS CTG Deductible:	- \$1,980	per semester
MINUS Amount Over CTG Deductible: (Difference between tuition scholarship (\$4,000) & CTG Deductible (\$1,980))	- \$2,020	per semester
TOTAL	\$8,556	per semester

****Amount of tuition grant payment = \$8,556 per semester****

Child on a Quarter System

If your child is attending a school on a quarterly schedule, then we allow for three quarters in an academic year. The annual academic year is pro-rated by taking one-third of the annual deductible and maximum grant amount.

For example: Annual Grant Amount of \$27,048.76 (\$13,524.38 X 2),
Then Max Quarter Amount would be \$9,371.25 per quarter (\$28,113.76 divided by 3)

Annual Deductible of \$3,960 (\$1,980 X 2),
Then the deductible would be \$1,320.00 per quarter (\$3,960 divided by 3)
