

How Much Can You Save?

Here's an example of how being a smart consumer for prescription drugs can save you money.

Susie Careful

Generic Prozac (depression)	\$10 co-pay
Generic Prilosec (acid reflux)	\$10 co-pay
Prescription Motrin (arthritis)	\$10 co-pay
	\$30 (30 day supply)

*Discounted mail order = \$60 (90-day supply)
 *(\$30 additional savings)

Annual cost via mail order = \$240

Saves approximately 1/3 by using Health Care Reimbursement Account

Total cost = **\$160**

Karen Careless

Paxil (depression)	\$20 co-pay
Nexxum (acid reflux)	\$20 co-pay
Vioxx (arthritis)	\$20 co-pay
	\$60 (30-day supply)

Local Pharmacy = \$180 (90-day supply)

Annual cost via pharmacy = \$720

Pays out out-of-pocket because did not enroll for reimbursement account

Total cost = **\$720**

Difference of \$560!
